  - robotics has ramifications (see below).

    Upper School Fall Athletics: Official practices for Upper School fall athletics (boys Ultimate, girls soccer, girls volleyball, co-ed cross country) begin running daily on August 20 and students are expected to make those practices. Washington State rules state that high school athletes must participate in 10 practices prior to competing in any contests. Students who cannot attend early practices will not be able to compete in the first two weeks of contests. Inability to attend summer practices may also jeopardize a student's ability to be on a Varsity team. There are optional July practices for some teams (volleyball, boys ultimate, boys basketball). Exact information will be communicated by coaches in the spring after sign-ups are complete.
  - □ **Upper School Robotics:** Practices start on August 27. Attendance is required. Joining Varsity requires qualification, including prior experience on an FTC team. Contact the coach regarding qualification. JV Robotics students are welcome to attend beginning August 27, however, attendance is not required until the start of school. No prior experience is required for JV.
