**1. EPS Administration (Vickie)**

- **Permanent Supporting Housing Update**
  - There are approximately 12 residents (mostly male) at the PSH with zero incidents to date. Four people are moving in per week as part of a slow ramp-up. Residents are allowed to have pets.
  - Average resident age is 60 years old
  - Our next meeting with the operator, county and city will be in March and we have requested a resident profile
  - Target demographic is individuals who are chronically homeless with at least one disability
  - We've spent the past two years working on language in the site's Code of Conduct and Good Neighbor Agreement
  - These documents also outline how we will interact with the site
  - More background checks are happening at this site than anywhere else in the county – possibly in the state
  - We've been lobbying the state government to retain the ability for cities and counties to enter into agreements like that which we have in place (Re: House Bill 2266). Some view these agreements as a barrier to entry for the unhoused.
  - Our approach has been to make this relationship a model that shows how well things can work when solid legal documents are in place protecting both the site and its neighbors. Our site is unique, however, due to the proximity of schools.
  - If any EPS community members observe concerning resident behavior, they should report it to Vickie directly so she can relay to the operator
